

The e-Edition Game

E-Editions are a great way to keep up with the news. They also are a great way to build skills in Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies. This game will help you practice moving through your e-Edition to find information you need.

You may play as individuals, in groups, or in teams as a class. You will need a game piece for each player or team and a coin to flip. (Heads—move one space and tails—move two spaces.) The goal is to earn two points in each of the three categories **QR** to reach the finish first.

To play, flip the coin and move your game piece. Each space asks you to find something in the e-Edition connected to Language (LA), Math/Science (M/S) or Social Studies (SS). If you find it place an "X" on your scoreboard in that category. If it is not in the paper, you receive no points.

To win the game you need two points each in Language, Math/Science and Social Studies. Once you earn those points—six points total—you may jump to the finish.

If you don't get two points in each subject area, you may still win by moving ahead across the board with each coin toss. Once you earn two points in one of the subject areas, you do not need to find any other items in that area.



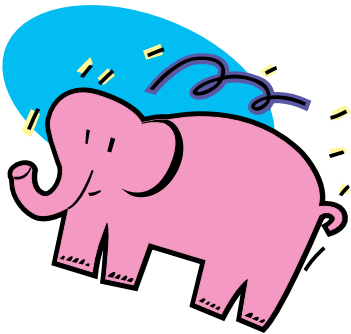
